Public Notice: Final Status Update for “Deep Water Point” (AQ#1080)
and “Little Burdock Cove” (AQ#1083) Marine Sites
January 14, 2022

The following is an update to a public notices originally posted on [November 30th, 2021](#) and [December 3rd, 2021](#) regarding the company’s “Deep Water Point” (AQ#1080) and “Little Burdock Cove” (AQ#1083) marine sites. The final tally for mortalities removed as a result of the environmental challenges experienced at these sites was 570,238 Atlantic salmon from the Deep Water Point site, and 184,598 Atlantic salmon from the Little Burdock Cove site. The mortalities were removed safely from site using approved procedures before rendering for the circular economy.

As previously reported, Marine Harvest Atlantic Canada is reviewing the environmental challenges experienced over the past months to develop enhanced strategies to manage for sea lice and other environmental pressures witnessed in this challenging farming area.

Marine Harvest Atlantic Canada has taken all responsible steps in this matter under the oversight of the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture.

We thank our farming, operations, and processing teams; as well as our key regional supply and service providers for their hard work, responsiveness, and attention to safety during this event.
