Eligibility:

To be eligible, you must be graduating in 2020 and entering your first year of University or College.

Evaluation Criteria:

Based on academic achievement, references, level of community involvement and volunteerism.

2. Resume and Cover Letter outlining the rationale why you should be the successful recipient
3. Three Reference Letters: Academic (1), Professional (1), and Personal (1)
4. Recent Transcript

Review Process:

Applications will be reviewed by the NAIA scholarship committee. Deadline for submissions: **July 1, 2020**. Only those applicants who are successful in their application will be notified.
