

**Marine Harvest Atlantic Canada  
Public Notice: Final Status Update for “Chaleur Bay” (AQ#1147) and  
“Friar Cove” (AQ#1148) Marine Sites  
November 26, 2021**

The following is an update to a public notice originally posted on [October 23rd, 2021](#) regarding the company’s “Chaleur Bay” (AQ#1147) and “Friar Cove” (AQ#1148) Marine Sites. The October 23<sup>rd</sup> notice confirmed an abnormal mortality event of Atlantic salmon spanning several weeks at each site and exceeding 10% of the total population. Final tally of mortalities removed as a result of this event was 12% (~122,323) from the Chaleur Bay site, and 14% (~129,590) from the Friar Cove site.

Marine Harvest Atlantic Canada will continue to review the environmental challenges experienced over the past months and develop enhanced strategies to manage the sea lice and environmental pressures in the area.

Marine Harvest Atlantic Canada has taken all responsible steps in this matter under the oversight of the Federal Department of Fisheries and Oceans and the Provincial Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture, and has followed government approved policies for reporting.

We thank our farming, operations, and processing teams; as well as our key regional supply and service providers for their hard work and responsiveness to this event.
