

**Cold Ocean Salmon Inc.**

**Statement regarding the detection of  
a federally reportable disease for a licensed aquaculture site**

In accordance with the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture (FFA) policy AP 17, Cold Ocean Salmon Inc. publicly advises that the company received two detections of Infectious Salmon Anaemia virus (ISAv) in one salmon cage at the North West Cove (AQ# 836) marine site. The cage has not been confirmed to be ISAv positive by FFA. The site is in Hermitage Bay and is currently being harvested; the cage is stocked with 47,000 Atlantic salmon.

Infectious Salmon Anemia virus (ISAv) is a naturally occurring virus in the ocean and is not a human health issue or a food safety issue.

The company is taking all the responsible steps under the oversight of the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture and is following government approved policies for reporting.
