Job Title: Technical Project Manager

Employment Term: 8 weeks x 35 hours per week (Start date June 30)

The Newfoundland and Labrador Aquaculture Industry Association (NAIA) is a member-based organization that represents the interests of seafood farmers and their suppliers in NL. We are passionate advocates on behalf of our members to facilitate and promote the responsible development of the aquaculture industry.

The role of the project manager will be to work with a team to promote marine debris awareness and help organize shoreline clean up events in partnership with industry, municipalities, and the public. The position will be working in both the satellite office in St. Alban's as well as an outdoor environment. They will also organize youth activities and events.

Some travel will be required so a drivers license is an asset, although not required. They will also assist with organizing the upcoming Conference and Trade Show taking place in September. Some training will be provided.

The student should demonstrate the following:

- (a) is between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the start of employment;
- (b) is a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act; and
- (c) is legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial / territorial legislation and regulations

Applications must be received by May 16. Only candidates selected for interviews will be notified.
