Statement regarding the detection of federally reportable diseases for a licensed aquaculture site

In accordance with the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Fisheries and Land Resources (FLR) policy AP 17, Cold Ocean Salmon Inc. publicly advises that on July 9, 2020, the company received a positive test result for Infectious Salmon Anaemia virus (ISAv) at the North of Killbuck Cove (AQ# 876) marine cage site. The farm site is located near McCallum, NL and contains six cages that are stocked with approximately 340,000 Atlantic salmon.

ISAv is a naturally occurring virus and is not a human health issue or a food safety issue. The ISAv detection was identified as a result of the FLR Atlantic salmon aquatic animal health surveillance program.

The company is making plans for fish removal using approved and biosecure Standard Operating Procedures. This proactive approach to removing fish immediately following a detection has proven to be the most successful method for managing this virus. The company has taken all the responsible steps under the oversight of the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Fisheries and Land Resources and is following government approved policies.
