Statement regarding the detection of federally reportable diseases for a licensed aquaculture site

In accordance with the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture policy AP 17, Cold Ocean Salmon Inc. publicly advises that the company received a positive detection of Infectious Pancreatic Necrosis virus (IPNv) at the Margery Cove (AQ# 944) marine cage site. The farm site is located near St. Alban's, NL and contains 8 cages that are stocked with approximately 310,000 trout.

IPNv is a naturally occurring virus and is not a human health issue or a food safety issue.

The company has taken all the responsible steps under the oversight of the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture and is following government approved policies for reporting.
