This position will be based out of our operations on the South Coast of NL with travel throughout the Maritimes required. Visits to freshwater facilities will also be required to collect health surveillance sampling, vaccination and brood stock sampling. As part of the fish health team, you will be supported but need to be resourceful with a self-reliant approach and do well under your own initiative.
